43	<b>Cabernet Sauvignon 2006, Vina Echeverria “Founders Selection”, Curico Valley, Chile*</b> <i>A Chilean masterpiece, Vina Echeverria winemakers have struck gold with their flagship wine. Gold medal winner at the 2010 World Wine Championship and rated 93 points, this Cabernet Sauvignon goes for the gusto. Packing aromas of chocolate, gunpowder, deep rich plum, and eucalyptus; this family made Cab will leave you wanting more. Vina Echeverria is a family run winery, of which all members are involved, making an unbeatable team, bonded together by the strongest forces of all: deep family roots, a shared passion for winemaking, an uncompromising search for excellence and a total commitment to their customers' satisfaction.</i>	90
66	<b>Pinot Noir 2004, Le Grand Clos Jordanne, VQA Niagara</b> <i>“Le Grand Clos, the “Grand Cru “of Niagara is created exclusively from the Le Clos Jordanne Vineyard’s best parcels, in only the best years. This wine is a rare breed exemplifying elegance, character, complexity, longevity and purity at its peak. It is deep in colour, stunningly pure, rich in sheer fruit extract and density and incredibly long in the mouth. This wine delivers intense floral overtones with luscious fruit flavours of ripe raspberries and dense black fruit.”</i>	98
45	<b>Nebbiolo 1996, Michele Chiarlo Barolo Cannubi ,D.O.C.G Piedmont, Italy*</b> <i>A silky-smooth Barolo with deep complexity, this wine will satisfy all of your desires. Suggestive aromas of licorice, cinnamon, mint, and dried rose petals precede a full palate with chewy tannins. Almost Port-like in texture, with undertones of vanilla and a lingering finish with hints of bitter almonds. Cellared for the last 14 years, this magnificent Barolo will awaken your palate and tease your senses.</i>	150
106	<b>Cornas 2008, Domaine Auguste Clape, Northern Rhone, France*</b> <i>In the world of wine, there are many good winegrowers. However, there are only a very select few who are truly great, and Auguste Clape is among them. Critics and connoisseurs alike all agree that he is one of the greatest pioneers of the Northern Rhône, and his Syrahs from the cru of Cornas are among the most celebrated wines of France. the 2008 Cornas boasts an opaque purple color as well as a sumptuously sweet, perfumed nose of white flowers, creme de cassis, melted licorice, and hints of roasted earth and meat.</i>	151
53	<b>Amarone 2003, Marchesi Fumanelli “Octavius”, Valpolicella Italy*</b> <i>The Squarano vineyards are situated in the heart of the most classic part of Valpolicella, on a hill surrounded by cypress groves. It is here that the Fumanelli family has maintained their vineyards and produced wine since the 15th century. Based on a respectful relationship with the land, local traditions and culture, the wines of Fumanelli are best described as vibrant and authentic. Intense ruby red with slightly brick coloured reflexes, typical nose of cherries and sweet notes of vanilla, spiced with nutmeg and cocoa. Full bodied and warm on the palate, soft yet powerful and incredibly long lasting.</i>	152
65	<b>Cabernet Sauvignon 2003, Cliff Lede “Poetry”, Howell Mountain, Napa Valley*</b> <i>Dark garnet-red in color ,clear and clean; the bouquet is filled with cassis, berries, spice, and dark chocolate, accented with the earth and mineral notes that define Howell Mountain; all this is echoed on the palate, which is big, mouth-filling, round and rich. This wine boasts great structure, firm tannins at the ore, and ample, ripe fruit, which is carried into the long, flavorful finish. “Poetry” is produced in very limited quantities and only during the years in which the grapes are deemed worthy enough to become the wine.</i>	177

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
