

## ~Wines by the glass~

### Red Wines

6oz/9oz/Bottle

- 100 Cabernet Franc/Cabernet Sauvignon, 2006, Jackson Triggs, Niagara** **7/9.5/28**  
An assemblage of two classic Bordeaux varietals. The wine is intensely aromatic, exhibiting a core of ripe plum, anise, blackcurrant and bell pepper. Rich fruit flavours supported by firm leather tannins lead to a rich extended finish.
- 101 Merlot 2008, Echeverria, Curico Valley, Chile** **8/11.50/31**  
Garnet red with purple hues. Intense aromas of strawberries and blackberries combine nicely with notes of black pepper and dried fruits leading to a fruity finish.
- 78 Shiraz 2009, Tall Poppy, Victoria, Australia** **9/12.50/33**  
A full bodied rich wine with plum and spice flavours, fine tannins and a lingering finish.
- 37 Primitivo 2009, Vinicola Tombacco, Puglia, Italy IGT** **9.50/13.50/33**  
Soft and sweet on the palate with some residual sugar. Note aromas of chocolate, anise, and fresh peppercorn. Lush with soft, sweet tannins that boasts the wine's full, round palate
- 61 Malbec 2008, Andeluna Cellars, Argentina** **9.50/13.50/35**  
Boasting aromas of ripe plum, red currant, blackberry, cherry and vanilla with notes of raspberry, chocolate and coffee. Similar flavours on the palate followed by a sweet, medium finish.
- 36 Cabernet Sauvignon 2007, Paso Creek, Paso Robles, California** **10/14/40**  
Dark cherry red in colour, this wine offers many layers of aromatics. Note the caramel, vanilla, pepper, and dark chocolate on the nose followed by a supple finish with touches of dark cherry and cocoa.
- 110 Pinot Noir, 2007, Zenith Vineyards, Willamette Valley, Oregon** **11.50/16.50/45**  
Subtle minerality breaks through rich fruit flavours and smooth tannins. Floral aromas undertone a nose of dark cherries that leave the senses wanting more

### White Wines

- 1 Chardonnay 2008, Jackson Triggs, Niagara** **7/10/28**  
Dry and full-bodied with fragrant aromas reminiscent of ripe apples and pears. A hint of oak and butter combine for a lingering, complex finish.
- 3 Sauvignon Blanc, 2009, Echeverria, Curico Valley, Chile** **8/11.50/31**  
Combination of fresh herbs, green pepper and tomato leaves, with citric notes of grapefruit and lime. The palate is fresh and crisp with a balanced natural acidity and a fruity finish.
- 4 Pinot Grigio 2008, Serenissima, Veneto, Italy, IGT** **9/12.50/33**  
A traditional light bodied Italian Pinot Grigio with hints of citrus and a clean, crisp finish.
- 25 Sauvignon Blanc, 2007, Hamelin Bay, Margaret River, Australia** **9.50/13.50/35**  
A semi-sweet palate consisting of ripe citrus fruit, lychee, and refreshing apple. A crisp palate precedes extraordinary length and a crisp, clean finish.
- 15 Chardonnay, 2007, Langtry Estates & Vineyards, Guenoc, California.** **10/14/40**  
Brilliant in colour and on the nose, this California Chardonnay boasts generous peach, pear and tropical fruit flavours with a rich smooth finish.
- 26 Riesling, 2008, Thirty Bench, Beamsville Bench Appellation, Niagara** **12/17/48**  
Dry and refreshingly crisp, this medium-bodied Riesling boasts over-ripe citrus and good minerality to the palate. Note a crisp, endlessly long finish.
